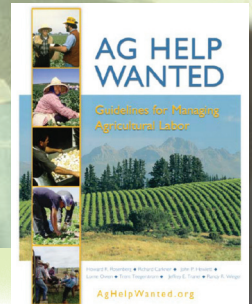
Supervisors' prerogatives to reward and threaten have been greatly reduced over the years
