

Assessing Labor Needs

A labor estimate worksheet that lays out tasks by month or week throughout the year can be used to organize data.

Taking careful stock of business labor requirements, the current workforce, and your own skills should yield a good sense, of the match between organizational needs and current staffing. Existing business records and knowledge about the skills, past performance, and aspirations of current farm staff, including the owner's family members in the business, are useful.
