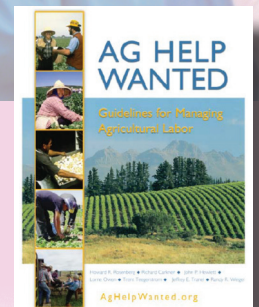
Interpersonal Communications
